

# Paediatric Surgery Courses at The Royal College of Surgeons of England 2009-10

## Neonatology for Neonatologists

5 November 2009

Fee: Consultants £225 | Trainees £180

Nurses £120

This NEW course is the first of its kind. There are a number of congenital anomalies that present in the newborn period with either respiratory or intestinal symptoms or signs. Up to 10% of babies on neonatal units get NEC. Many of these babies need urgent surgical intervention. This course provides the opportunity to revise and discuss these conditions and their pre and post operative management with a group of specialist surgeons.

This course is designed specifically for those looking after newborns on neonatal units but will be of significance to other paediatricians and other healthcare professionals.

## Basic Sciences in Paediatric Surgery

23-25 November 2009 Fee: tbc

This 3 day course was originally convened by BAPS and held in Birmingham from 1998 to 2004. It was well received and over subscribed. This new course is an evolution of the old course and aims to stimulate paediatric surgeons to think. You will be challenged with questions about the basic sciences relevant to paediatric surgery; you will be given pre-course exercises and problems to solve. The course is not aimed to be a clinical course but the relevance underpins what happens in the clinical environment.

## Common Elective and Acute Problems in the General Surgery of Childhood

3-4 December 2009 Fee: tbc

This course aims to update the current management of common paediatric surgical problems. The intention is not only to cover some important surgical conditions but to stimulate a wider interest in the care of the child. This two day course is aimed at surgeons and trainees in General surgery and trainees (ST1-2) in Paediatric Surgery.

## Operative Skills in Neonatal and Paediatric Surgery (Formerly Core Skills in Paediatric Surgery)

19-20 January 2010 Fee: tbc

A very popular two-day course designed to develop a trainee's surgical skills focusing on the management of a number of neonatal and infant conditions. The course is interactive, teaching a high degree of practical skills training using specially designed models. It is a small and intensive course, with a high faculty to participant ratio.

This course is aimed at ST 3-5.
